What are the benefits of integrating an EPR system?

- **Patient referral and demographic data** is immediately pulled through from the EPR system, ensuring staff have access accurate data. Integration also enables data to flow both ways between the two systems, ensuring data accuracy and reducing admin.
- With an integration, **referrals are automatically pulled into the workforce scheduling system**, allowing for quicker and easier management of referrals, increasing the speed of treatment plans and reducing admin. Transparency for clinicians helps ensure less missed visits or errors in care, where information has not been updated in a timely manner.
- **Data accuracy and visibility is ensured**. With data being pulled through an integration, clinicians can be confident that they are viewing the most up-to-date information. This is especially important for visibility of details around further illness or injury that would need to be communicated quickly for a patient receiving regular care.
- Data sharing and information governance is safeguarded. With important and sensitive information being transferred directly from one system to another, an integration removes any possibility of human error, providing reassurance that information being used to decide when, how and what care is being provided to a patient, is accurate and safe.

"The integration between Allocate eCommunity and Rio is a real gamechanger. With an average of 227 referrals a day, across 39 teams, the time spent duplicating information across the system takes up to 10 minutes per referral.
